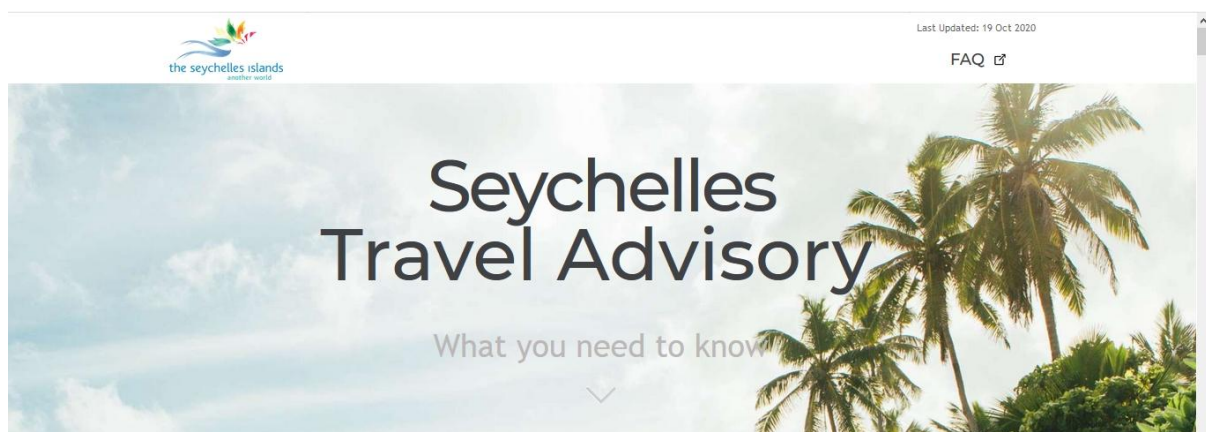
Roseharrycove is a certified Category 1 and category 2 accommodation establishment.

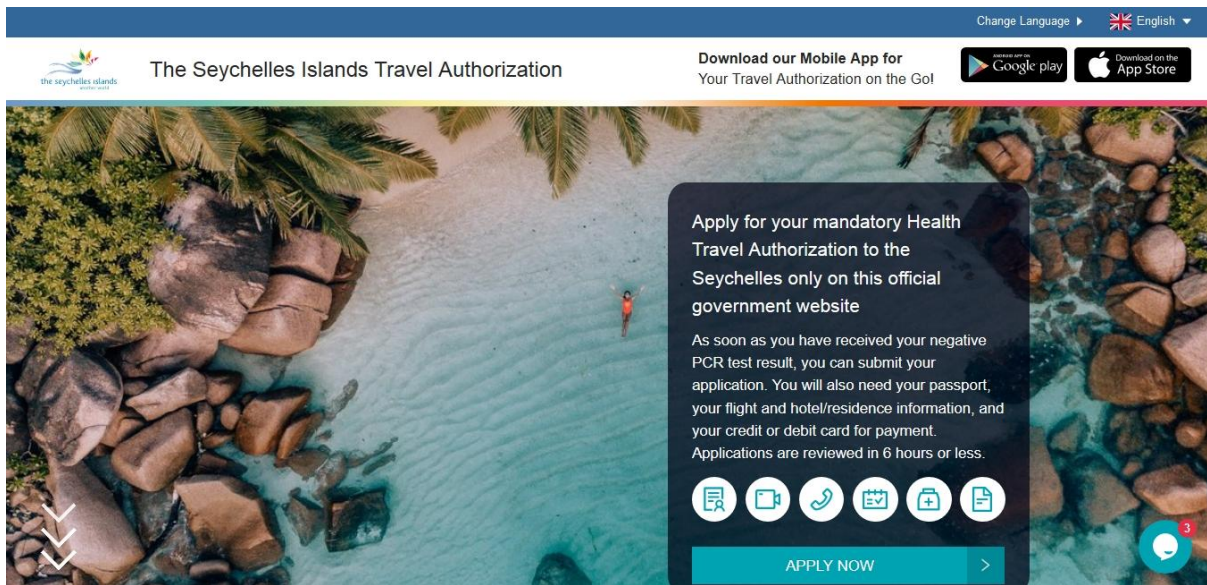
Belhorizon provides a safe and relaxing environment for its clients. Our trained staff are always ready to help make client's stay a memorable one.
